

PROJECT SUMMARY:

Programmatic Categorical Exclusion, Coliseum and Cunningham Drive Intersection Improvements, City of Hampton, Virginia

Description: REMSA, Inc. was contracted by the City of Hampton to complete a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion for intersection improvements at Coliseum and Cunningham Drives. The purpose for the National Environmental Policy Act document was to obtain Federal funding via submittal to the Federal Highway Administration.



The project involved less than one third of an acre of additional right of way for widening of Coliseum Drive to allow dual northbound and southbound left turn lanes, widening Cunningham Drive to allow for an exclusive eastbound right turn lane, new mast arm signals and related appurtenances. Some traffic control easements were likely required for signal poles and cabinet. Pavement width would increase 11 feet. Ten feet of additional right of way was required on each flank of Cunningham Drive.

The Programmatic Categorical Exclusion document consisted of coordination with a number of agencies for concurrence that the project would have no significant impact on the community or the environment. Among the agencies consulted were the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, the Virginia Department of Historic Resources, the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.
